

Clinical Placement in Study Programme “Physiotherapy”

Description

Clinical placement in the study programme “Physiotherapy” starts at the beginning of the academic year in early September and lasts till March, spanning a period of more than 5 months. We provide 10 clinical placements in:

- 4 hospitals – 1 for children and 3 for adults,
- 3 multi-professional rehabilitation centres, and
- 3 smaller private ambulatory rehabilitation centres.

The hospitals are located in Rīga; however, the rehabilitation centres are located outside Rīga – with the exception of one intended for children. Our largest multi-professional rehabilitation centre “Vaivari” is located in Jūrmala, 30 km away from Rīga. All in all, students do 5 placements, spending 1 month in each placement. It is also possible to arrange 3-month placements (only in Rīga).

We are experienced in organising clinical placements for international (ERASMUS) students: our fourth year students will help you with language issues and other things. Our clinical instructors have a good command of English and they will explain all the necessary things regarding the placement.

Clinical placements are organised according to the following scheme: 5 days a week for 6 academic hours every working day. Throughout this period, students have to spend their time in hospitals or rehabilitation centres and, additionally, deal with paperwork and prepare for the placement. Every clinical placement has documentation that needs to be filled in, inclusive of ERASMUS exchange students.

We have the experience and the possibility to offer and organise clinical placements in orthopaedics (mostly for adults), neurology (adults and children), paediatrics and internal diseases in hospitals and rehabilitation centres.
