

## Study programme Medicine, study courses for the academic year 2026/2027

\* The course is conducted for two consecutive semesters (full academic year). Students are allowed to take an exam **only after completing both parts of the course**. If only the first part of the course is finished student can receive **only a “pass” in the transcript**. Student cannot be placed for one semester in second semesters group to receive a “grade”, both course parts need to be completed prior to the exam.
