

## Clinical Placement in Study Program “Midwifery”

### **Procedure for applying for placements:**

Students are nominated by a partner university through our website by the 15th of May.

**This program offers placement only in Autumn semester.** The nomination is then reviewed and either approved or declined. If approved, the student will receive information about the further application process.

**Please note that nomination can be declined if suitable placement cannot be found for the time frame that is needed.**

In the Learning Agreement that needs to be included in the application form, information about the placement is required, such as the desired fields, number of hours, hours per day, evaluation, etc. After this information is provided, a detailed placement plan will be arranged with the hospitals based on the free practical spaces available at clinical practice base/hospital.

**Clinical Practice II:** The Faculty of Health and Sport Sciences offers exchange students enrolled in the Midwifery study programme the opportunity to gain clinical experience in the perinatal healthcare process in a hospital setting.

Placements can be arranged based on the availability of practical training positions at clinical practice sites/hospitals providing perinatal healthcare.

Clinical placements are organized according to the following schedule: five working days per week, with six academic hours per day. During this period, students are required to actively participate in perinatal healthcare activities, in compliance with the institution's internal regulations, under the supervision of a designated midwife. Students are also required to complete all necessary documentation. Each clinical placement includes mandatory documentation, particularly for ERASMUS+ exchange students.
