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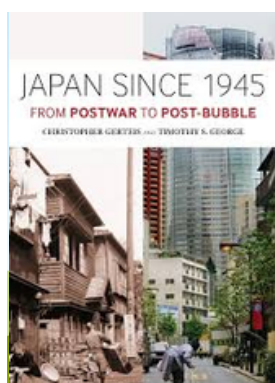

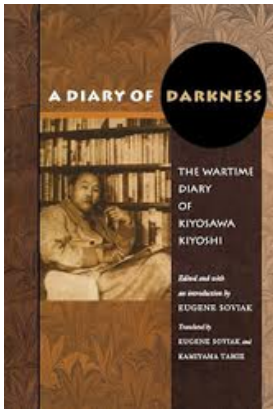

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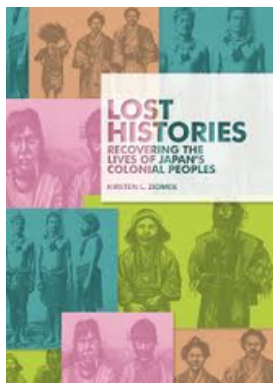


Japan's imperial house in the postwar era, 1945-2019 | Kenneth J. Ruoff
