
Instructions for requesting items via RSU Catalogue




ALEPH password example: ParoleLV2017* (you can choose your own password by contacting a librarian)

2. After successfully signing in, switch the webpage language by choosing "English" in the upper right corner.



3. You will now see the "Basic search" page. Select the appropriate search criteria to find the needed item. For example, you can choose to search by the field "Title":




You can also find useful search hints here:

Search hints:

- If you choose Yes for "Words adjacent," you can type in the phrase computer programming and the system will understand that you want only records that have the word computer NEXT to the word programming.
- Lowercase letters will find matches of capitalized words also. For example, computer will find matches for computer, Computer and COMPUTER.
- You may use the Boolean operators AND and OR in your search string. For example, you could type (heart OR cardiac) AND surgery to retrieve all records having heart or cardiac in them, together with the word surgery.
- Use the ? character to find matches that contain portions of words. For example, gun? will retrieve gun, guns, gunners, gunners, gunning, etc. In another example, ? ology will retrieve anthropology, archaeology, psychology, etc. The ? character may also be used to find variant spellings. For example, alumi?m will find both the American spelling, aluminum, and the British spelling, aluminium.
 - 4. After finding the necessary item in the Aleph Catalogue, you can request it at your most convenient RSU Library branch, for example, the RSU Library Information Center for Latvian Health Care Professionals:




NB! Before requesting the item, make sure to check its item status. **Items marked as** "Special item" are only available at the reading room!




After successfully requesting the item you will receive a message in the Catalogue:
