# Development of the SLI - facts

1988	Initiative group started to work out a new labour protection law
1991	Latvia gained independence
1992	First visit of ILO expert: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• evaluation of situation,</li><li>• proposals on the draft of labour protection law</li></ul> The government decided to establish SLI
1993	SLI launched its activities - 43 persons Parliament adopted labour protection law, SLI law Cooperation was established with Sweden

# Development of the SLI - facts



1994	<p>3 regional inspectorates were established (86 persons) ILO conventions (81; 129; 155) were ratified Staff – 181 persons SLI became a member of the International Association of Labour Inspection Cooperation agreement between SLI of the Baltic countries “Gosgortehnadzor” was reorganized (supervision and registration of dangerous equipment - under SLI)</p>
1995	<p>Latvia signed associative agreement with the EU Co-operation was established with the Danish Working Environment Authority Latvia became an associated member of SLIC</p>

# Development of the SLI - facts



2001	National Focal Point for EU-OSHA was established
2002	New Labour Protection Law came in force transposing Framework directive (89/391/EEK) EC audit of SLI
2002-2007	Transposing of EU directives (around 20)
2003	1st Good Practice Award was organized
2005	ILO Tripartite audit
2007	Staff – 238 persons National Inspection campaigns were implemented

# Development of the SLI - facts



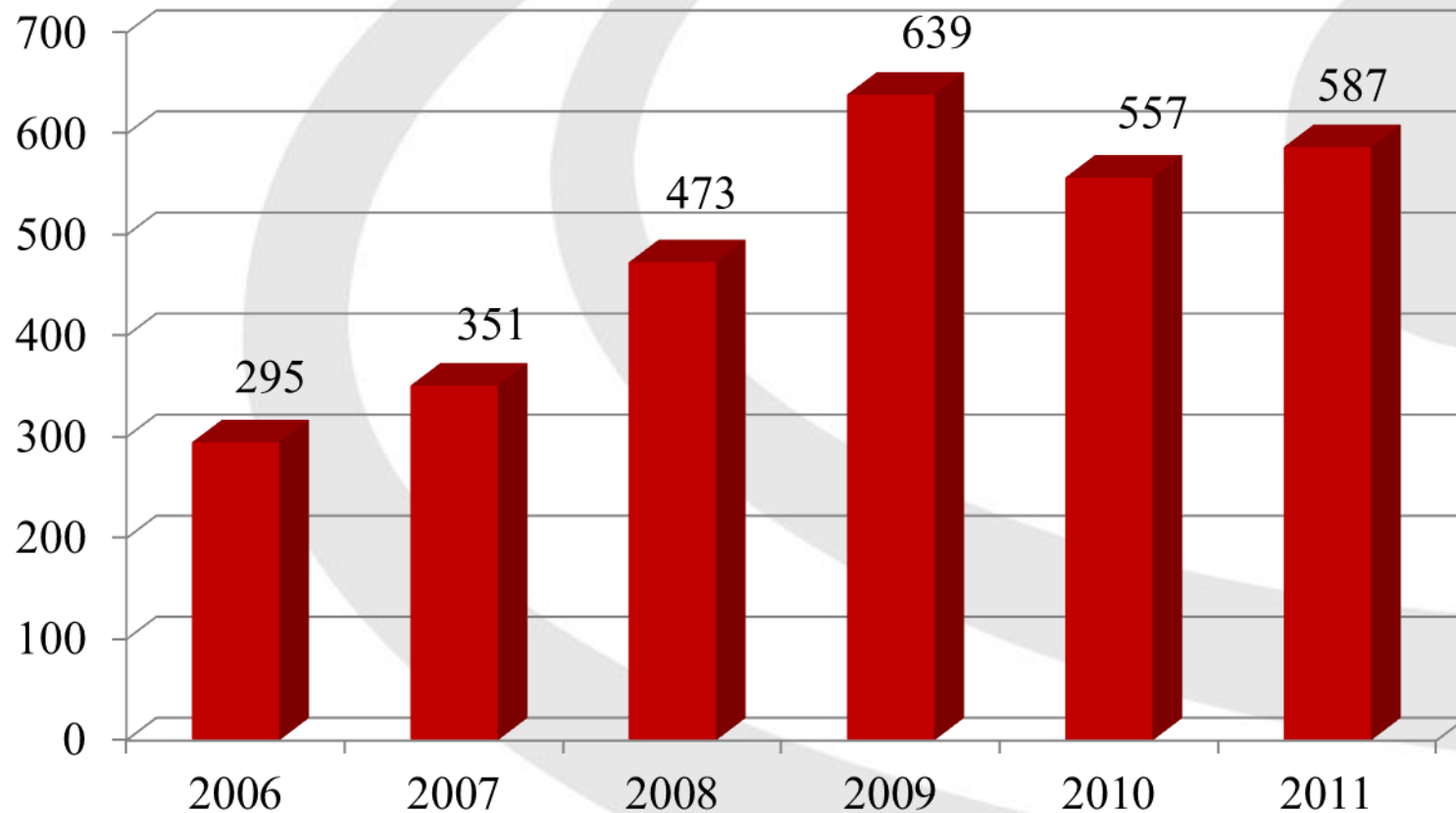
2008	New SLI law (labour legal rights / OHS) Supervision and registration of dangerous equipment – transferred to the Ministry of Economy National OSH policy – reduction of fatal accidents for 30%
2009	Preventive campaign «Work safely» Reduction of number of inspectors and salaries – around 30%
2011	EC audit of SLI
2012	SLI participates in the audit of SLI in Romania Staff – 158 persons

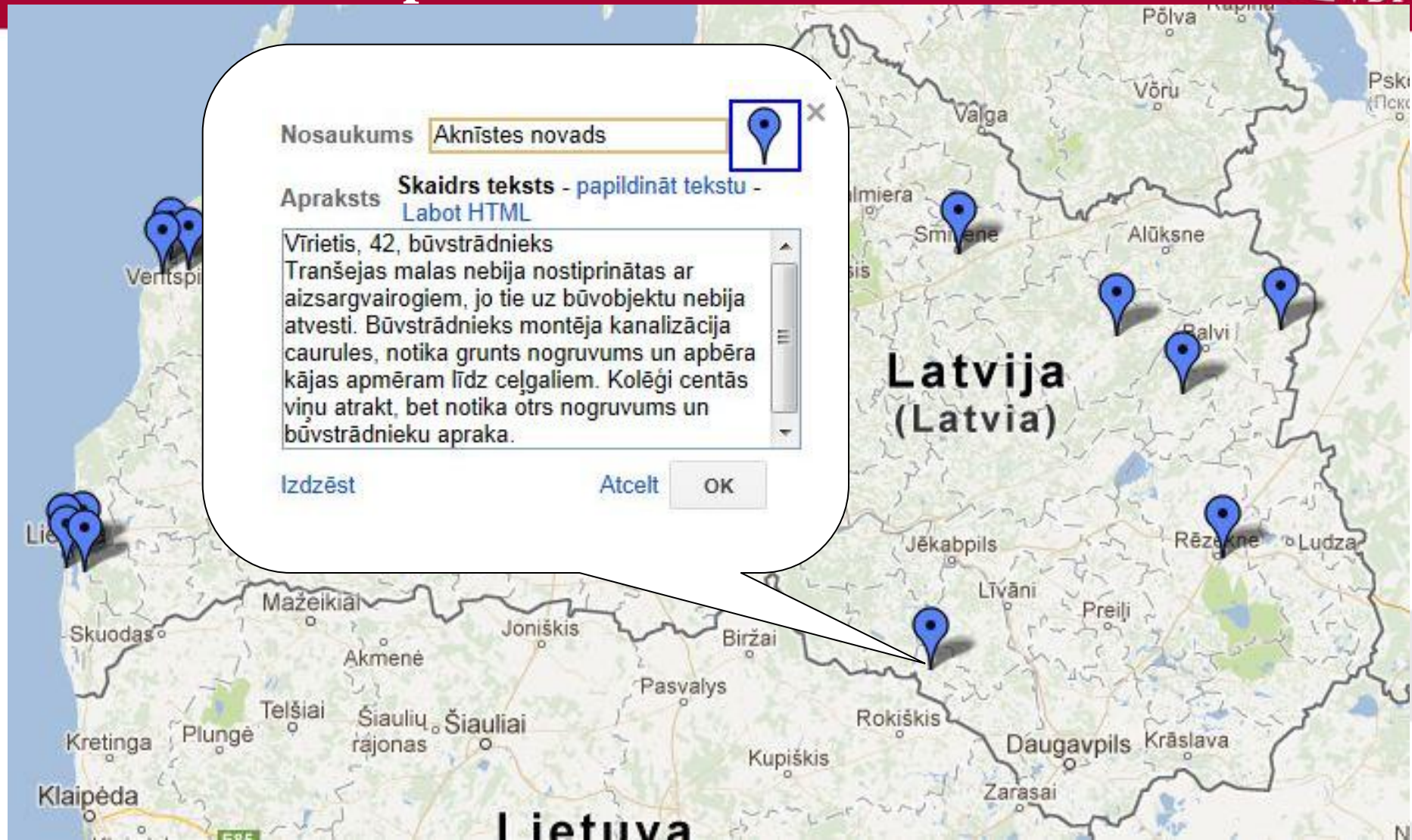
# Complaints received by the SLI per 100 000 employees (2006 – 2011)
